Concerning the UCI Artistic Cycling World Cup leader jersey please note the rules as follow: For each discipline, the UCI shall award a leader's jersey at each event of the series. The leader's jersey may only be worn at UCI Artistic Cycling World Cup events, and in no other event. The colours of the leader's jerseys are determined by the UCI. Further details are regulated in article 1.3.055 bis. (UCI Cycling Regulations, Part 1 General organisation of cycling as a sport).
